GERARD HOME & SCHOOL ASSOCIATION MEETING - On Thursday, September 21, you will have an opportunity to meet all of your student's teachers. The regular meeting of the Gerard Home & School Association will be held on Thursday, September 21, 1967, in St. Thomas More Hall at 7:30 p.m. After a brief meeting in the Hall, you will go to meet the teachers in the individual classrooms according to your student's schedule. (Your student will bring a schedule home from school on Thursday; be sure to ask him for it.) There will be ten-minute "classes". There will be a five-minute period in between classes to allow you to get to the next classroom. At 9:15, you will return to St. Thomas More Hall for the conclusion of the meeting and for refreshments. During this time, you will be able to meet some of the other members of the faculty and other parents. We sincerely hope that every student at Gerard High School will have at least one of his parents attend this very important meeting. All parents, as well as guardians, of students who attend Gerard High School, and the faculty, are automatically members of the Gerard Home & School Association. The annual dues for the Association are \$1.00 per year. These dues are payable at this first meeting of the school year.

FOOTBALL - The first Varsity football game of the Gerard High School team will be played with Judson High School at Camelback stadium, 4612 North 28th Street, Phoenix, at 8:00 p.m., Friday, September 22. This will be our first home game of the season. We hope all the Redcoat rooters will be on hand. The second Varsity football game will be played against Buckeye High School at the Buckeye stadium on Friday, September 29. There will be a Junior Varsity game at Buckeye on Thursday, September 28, at 4:00 p.m. Freshmen will play Buckeye also on Thursday, September 28, at 4:00 p.m. SUPPORT THE REDCOATS!

ATTENDANCE - No student should be absent at any time except for serious reasons. Parents should call the school before 9:00 a.m. to report absences. When students return after being absent, they must bring to Room 150 a written note signed by a parent or guardian and containing the date of return, number of days absent and reason for absence. The student's name should be written in the lower left hand corner as a convenience for office filing. The office will issue a re-admit slip to the student. This slip must be presented for the signature of each teacher whose class was missed, and is returned to the office at dismissal time. Absence, even when avoidable, directly affects grades. It is the student's responsibility to make up the work missed.

Classes officially start at the sound of the second bell. Any student who enters class after this time is tardy. Students who are tardy for the first period must report to Room 150 for a permit slip to enter class. If the tardiness is for a legitimate reason, the student brings a note signed by a parent stating the reason for the tardiness. This note may be presented on the following day if the tardiness was not foreseen.
